Coffee & Snack Shops in New York contributes **8.8%** to the total national industry's revenue of **\$75.5 billion**, ranking New York  **2nd** out of 50 states in total industry revenue.

Employment

Employment for Coffee & Snack Shops in New York totals an estimated **75,468** which increased an annualized **5.4%** over the past five years. New York employs the  **2nd**-most employees nationwide.

Wages

Total wages for Coffee & Snack Shops in New York amount to **\$2.3 billion**, which increased an annualized 6.3% over the past five years. The average wage of Coffee & Snack Shops employees in New York is **\$30,087**, which is **35.3% higher** than the industry's national average wage of \$22,238.

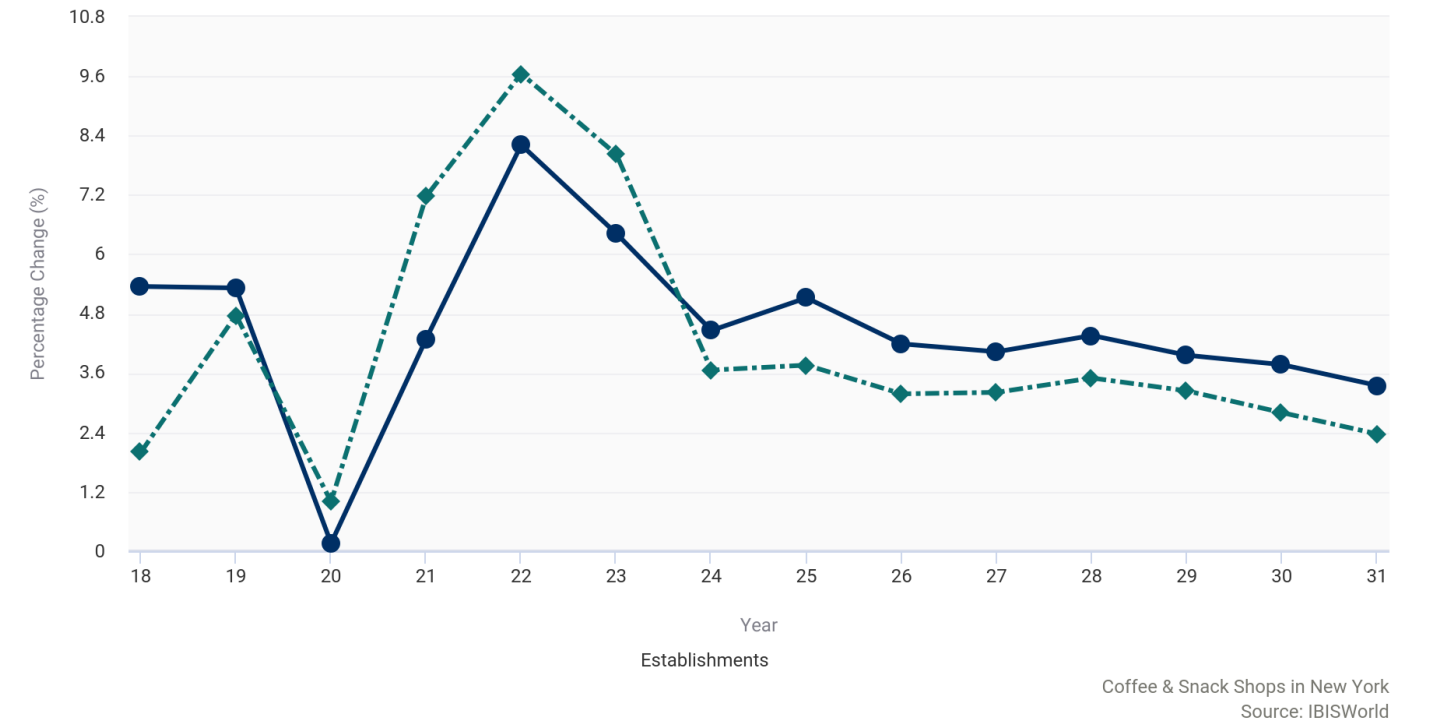

Current Performance & Outlook

The Coffee & Snack Shops industry in New York is expected to grow an annualized 1.8% to \$6.6 billion over the five years to 2026, while the national industry will likely grow at 2.5% during the same period. Industry establishments increased an annualized 5.7% to 10,186 locations. Industry employment has increased an annualized 5.4% to 75,468 workers, while industry wages have increased an annualized 6.3% to \$2.3 billion.

Over the five years to 2031, the industry is expected to grow an annualized 0.5% to \$6.8 billion, while the national industry is expected to grow 0.5%. Industry establishments are forecast to grow 3.9% to 12,328 locations. Industry employment is expected to increase an annualized 1.7% to 82,096 workers, while industry wages are forecast to increase 1% to \$2.4 billion.

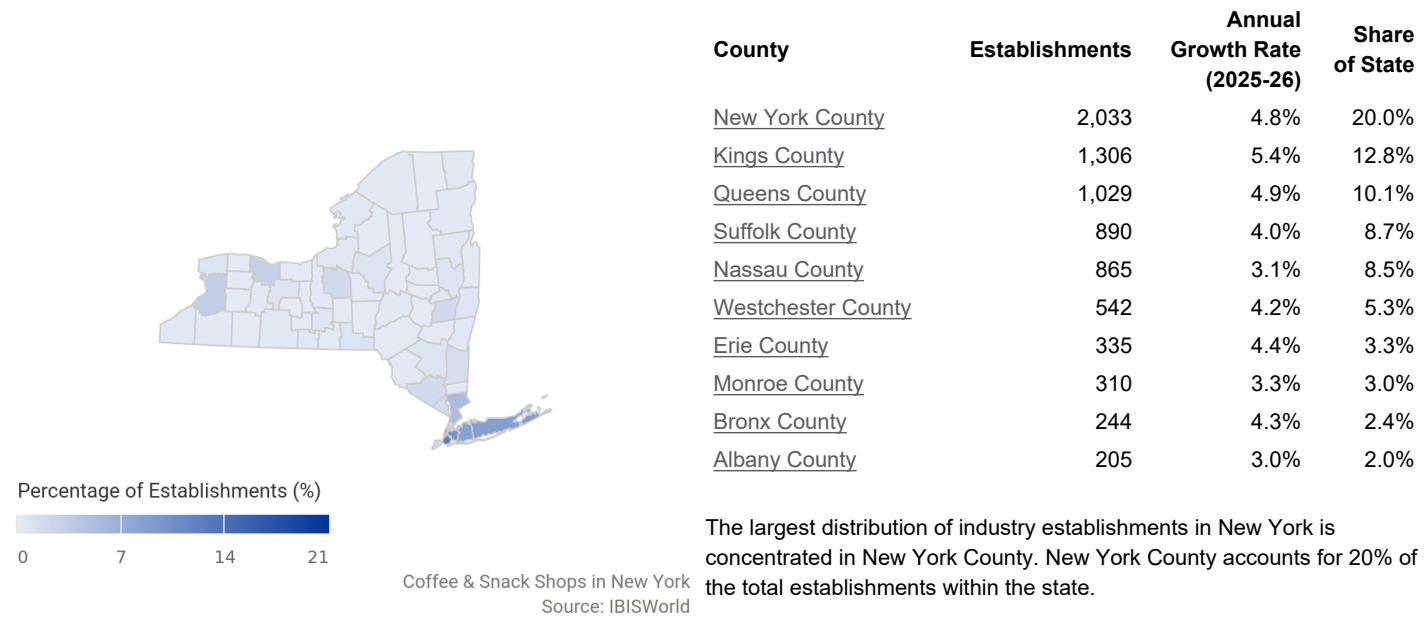

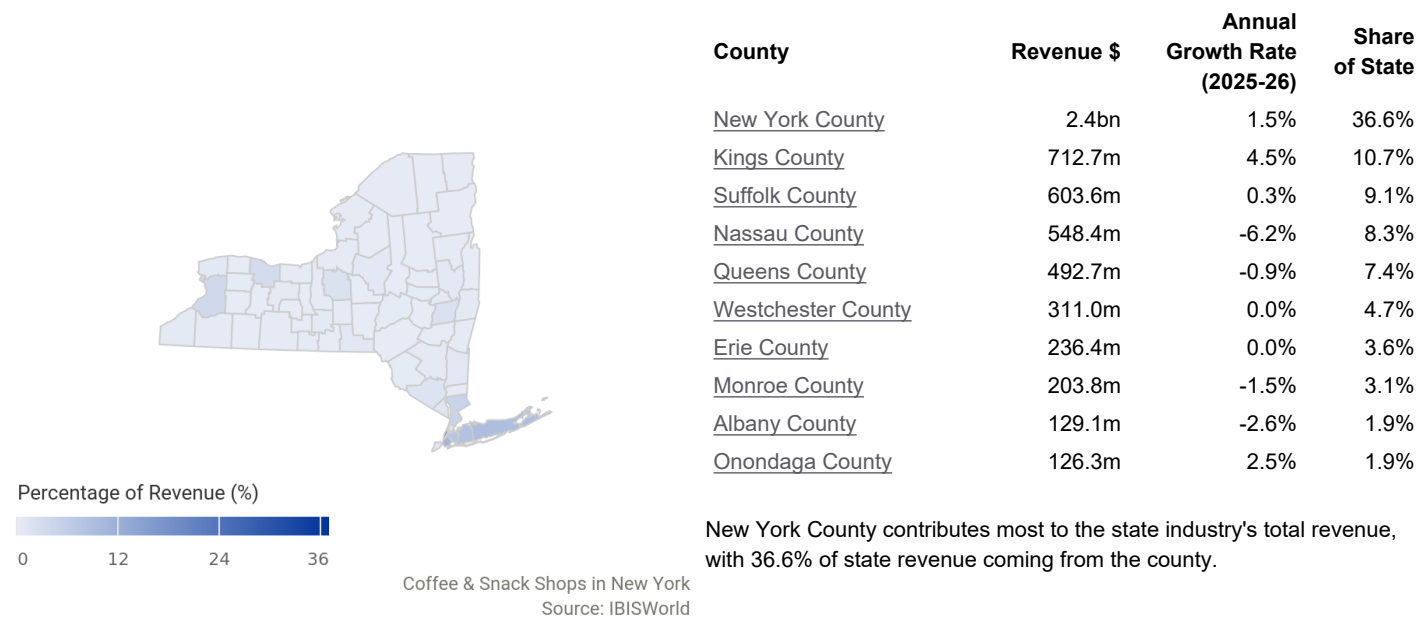

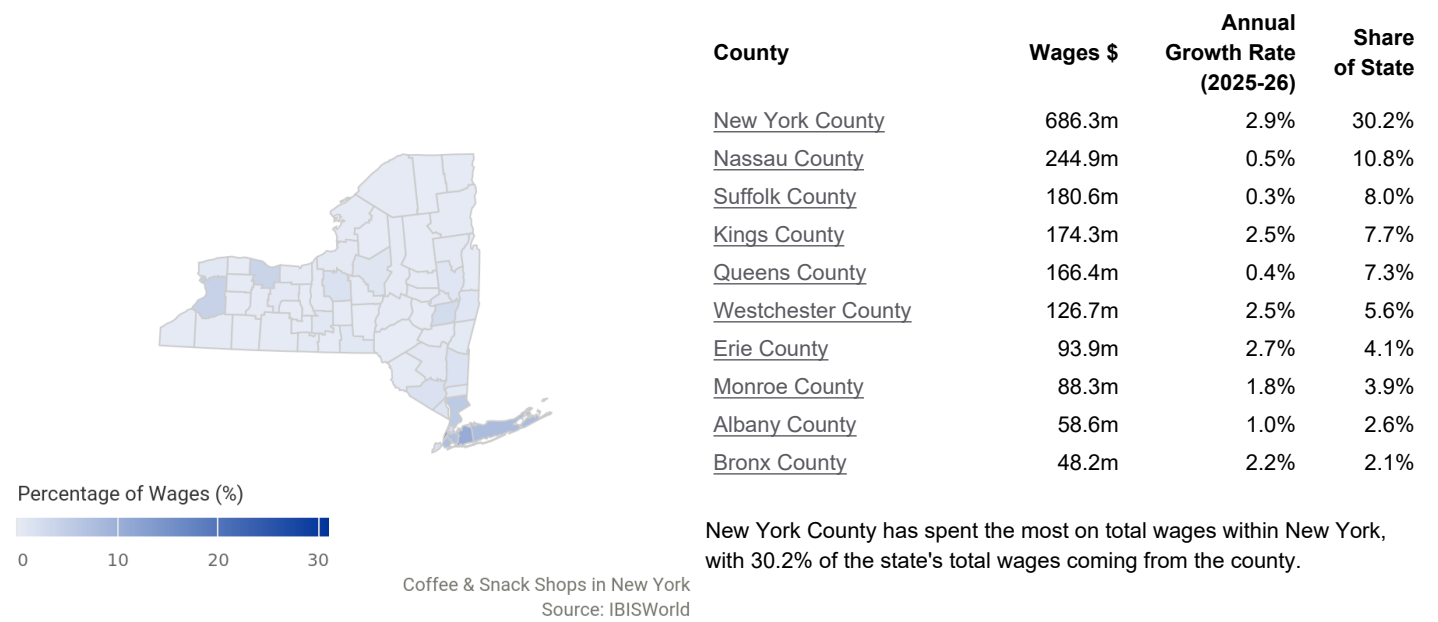
