
# **Unemployment Outlook**



- January unemployment levels were at just 4.9%
- Strong and sustained government support will delay unemployment peak to 6.5% at the end of this year
- Unwinding of government support will see unemployment levels begin to rise
- March COVID unemployment gap was at 6.2 million people in March

## Retail and Wholesale sector



### Retail and Wholesale Index



- The Retail and Wholesale index had recovered to February levels by July 2020.
- At its peak in October 2020, the index of services remained
  5.1% lower than its index score in February.
- Despite continued restrictions, the Retail and Wholesale index returned to growth in February 2021.

#### **UK Index of services**

While largely remaining in line with the index of services prior to the pandemic, wholesale and retail trade recovered at a much faster rate than the wider sector due to increasing reliance on online retail and food retailers.




## Average weekly revenue - Retail




#### Average weekly revenue of small retail businesses

Small Non-store retailers rapidly over took small food retailers following the initial outbreak and have remained higher in each month since.



#### Average weekly revenue for large retail businesses

The scale of UK supermarkets inflates the size of large food stores well above large businesses in other industries, while demand for clothing has plummeted.
