SWOT

HOK Group Inc. has less pricing power than its competitors, which severely limits the company's ability to raise prices and increase profitability without risking the loss of customers.

HOK Group Inc. has a similar number of employees to its competitors, which means that it has a similar operational capacity.

HOK Group Inc. only operates in the United States at a national level, indicating that it does not have a global presence.
